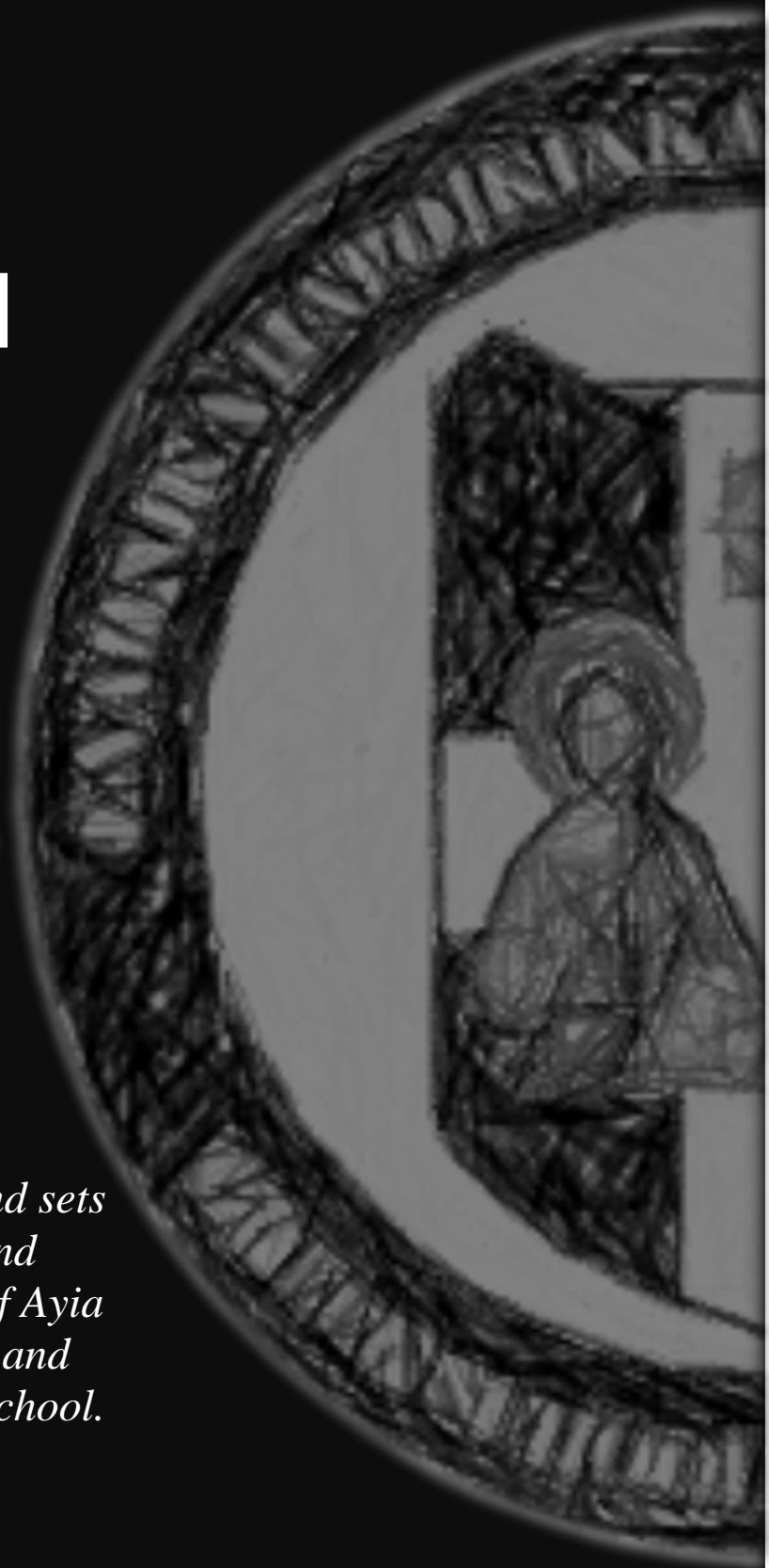

Home/School Agreement

In line with sections 110 and 111 of School Standards Framework Act 1998 (revised 2013) all schools should have a home-school agreement and associated parental declaration. It is a statutory Requirement that we, the Greek School of Ayia Triada Bham, establish a home-school agreement. In the next page you have an overview of this agreement which includes a range of aims in which we can all work together, in partnership for the benefit of your child.

You will receive a copy of the agreement which you should sign and return to the school. Please discuss this agreement with your child as you feel their knowledge and understanding develops. The school will reinforce the aspects of this agreement, as your child moves through each year group.

- The importance of, and responsibility for, good discipline and behaviour
- What is expected from the school, parents and children in relation to homework
- The information school and parents will share
